Located a mere two and a half hour's drive from Sydney and recognised for consistently achieving outstanding HSC results, All Saints' College aims to foster the best in every student.

A non-selective, Pre-Kindergarten to Year 12 co-educational school, All Saints' College offers encouraging and dynamic programs to both boarding and day students of all abilities and backgrounds within a safe, picturesque, country setting. Maintaining a wide range of subjects and co-curricular activities, this beautiful College gives every child in its care the opportunity and resources to grow – spiritually, academically, culturally and socially.



LOCATION

Located in the historic city of Bathurst and approximately two and a half hours' drive west of Sydney, All Saints' College campus is set on 30 magnificent landscaped hectares of parkland by the Macquarie River. The stunning position of the College in the Bathurst landscape provides an ideal setting for young people to thrive in a safe and secure environment, with all of the advantages of a regional setting.

SENSITIVE CARE FOR ALL STUDENTS

All Saints' College has been sensitively caring for young Australians since 1874. Offering a values-based education and working in partnership with the home, the College offers every student an extended family of care, where each girl and boy can feel safe as they grow, learn and explore. The pastoral care at All Saints' is specifically designed to cater to the needs of each individual student. The College is fortunate to have the services of a full time Chaplain who resides with his family on campus.

BOARDING - A NUTURING ENVIRONMENT

The College offers accommodation for up to 150 Year 7 to 12 students in four on-campus houses. Boys are accommodated in Watson House. Junior girls are accommodated in Lyon Wing and Marsden Wing.

Each House provides residential and study facilities with Internet access, common rooms with a small kitchen and a pleasant outdoor area. Within each house complex accommodation is provided for the Head of House, Assistant Head of House and Residential Tutors.

The College operates as a small community with all residential staff engaged in providing a caring environment for the nurture of individual students and the development of their tolerance and co-operation. Communal meals, Chapel services and other activities assist in building a community spirit. House camps, trips away and other activities provide a break from the boarding house and allow friendships to develop in a less formal setting.

Boarding students at All Saints' College Bathurst are happy, healthy and trusting of each other and the staff. Their access to and communication with the staff at the College is one of openness, trust and respect.

THE CURRICULUM

The All Saints' College Senior School curriculum is designed to cater for a great diversity of interests and needs. This wide subject choice enables students to develop patterns of study that are highly appropriate to their career ambitions and future needs. In Years 11 & 12 English is a compulsory subject requirement of the NSW Board of Studies and additional subjects are chosen from the remaining seven Key Learning Areas. The pattern of these additional subjects follow Board of Studies requirements leading to the NSW Higher School Certificate.

CO-CURRICULAR PROGRAMME

Sports

Sport and physical competition of all types are a feature of student life at All Saints' College. The College has wonderful sporting facilities including three ovals, a gym and swimming pool. The popular team sports for boys include: rugby, basketball, tennis, cricket, and football. Whilst for girls, basketball, cricket, touch football, tennis, hockey, and the most popular of all, Netball.

Arts

The Creative and Performing Arts Department of All Saints' College encompasses the disciplines of Design and Technology, Drama, Music and Visual Arts. The vast All Saints' Music Programme involves every child through participation in small group instrumental lessons to the end of Year 8. Co-curricular orchestras, bands, choirs and ensembles are open to all and private instrumental lessons given by visiting specialists are very popular.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to undertake an assessment test to determine if a high school bridging English course is required prior to entry. The College has preferred testing providers. Please enquire to the College Directors of International Enrolments to assist with advice about testing and which language centre is preferred. Students who do not provide an assessment report must complete a minimum of 20 weeks of an English program prior to entry into the College. The College provides EAL support to students.
