SPORTS ACADEMY

The St Paul's Sports Academy focuses on developing students of all sporting ability into the best they can be.

It has relationships with a range of organisations such as the Independent Sporting Association (ISA), the Penrith Junior Cricket Association (PJCA), the Nepean District Soccer Football Association (NDSFA) and to allow all students to develop their sport beyond school. The Academy forges links with other local associations for Basketball and Netball for our Junior School students. All students have the opportunity to access specialist coaches, play in high level ISA and School teams and for teams to be entered in additional competitions like Gala Days.

THE ARTS

Full-fee paying overseas students can enter the school at any Year level if they are residing in Australia with their parents, if their level of English is appropriate and if there is a position available. The application procedures for Australians applies.

International students are accepted into both the Junior School and High School. Students seeking enrolment into the Junior School must be accompanied by a parent or relative that is from the approved Guardian category. High School students who are not accompanied by a parent or relative that is an approved Guardian are accommodated in school arranged homestays.

One of St Paul's International students indicates what it was like coming to St Paul's from another country:

"I came from north-east China to Year 11 at St Paul's and felt so alone at first. But my homestay family understood what it was like coming to a new country and they made me feel at home - they now look upon me as their Chinese daughter. I did the IB Diploma and did well - I am now studying Commerce at university, getting distinctions and above. I'm glad I went to the school - it was responsive to someone from a different culture and it gave me a chance to be successful in the IB."
